

## **Brown Hails STASI Achievements.**

Prime Minister Gordon Brown today hailed the achievements of STASI (Subdue Terrorism/ Aid Security Initiative) in making Great Britain safer. He said STASI activities over the last two years had made Britain a safer place for hard-working British families and a no-go area for terrorists and anti-social behaviour. Future plans include:

Raising the 4.2 million CCTV cameras to 7 million by June 2010.

Grand-parents to provide a certificate proving they do not suffer from Incipient Senile Dementia, before being allowed to look after their grand-children.

Finger-printing at places of public gathering - supermarkets, football matches, Covent Garden Opera House.

Westminster to have a wall built around it with bunkers for Ministers and MPs below.

Fines to be issued to families who do not consume food products before the 'best before' date.

Parking Attendants to be issued with powers of arrest.

The Prime Minister said further initiatives were under close review by STASI's Chief Executive Mark Wolf.
