

RINKZ Summit Welcomes Gordon Brown

The top-level Summit of the RINKZ group of countries (Russia, Iran, North Korea and Zimbabwe) welcomed British Prime Minister Gordon Brown as its key speaker yesterday.

Taking place in Mobanga Ogowe, the scene of recent political upheaval but now calm, the Summit is the first of annual top-level meetings planned for the RINKZ group.

Prime Minister Brown has been asked to address the Summit on a wide range of subjects covering:

Populace observation through CCTV,

Decisive monitoring of e-mail traffic,

Manipulation and discombulation of the media,

Stealth taxes,

Financial rewards for excellence in ministerial competence,

----- and in particular -----

Enlightened democracy. Centralisation of all decisions concerning the people. Governing with minimal mandates.

The leaders of the RINKZ group of countries hailed Prime Minister Brown as a welcome supporter of enlightened democracy. An armoured Mercedes Benz limousine will be presented to him at the end of the Summit.

It is expected that the Prime Minister will be asked to bring Britain into the group and it is believed his response will be favourable.
